New lease of life for community orchard

With all the houses now complete and occupied, a significant milestone is approaching as we prepare to take on the 50 year lease for the Community Orchard.

As well as gearing up to make the most of this fantastic local resource, we will also now begin fund raising to secure the Orchard's long-term future through a 999 year lease. It has always been our goal to look after this place in perpetuity (or as close as we can get) and we need to raise £45k to do so.
