We are hoping to close a section of Irvine Road to allow for a safe space for the event. Some cars will need to be moved and we'd like to say thanks to all of those who have offered to do so.

There will be refreshments available, a space for tabletop sales of residents' crafts, plants and maybe a toy and book table if residents would like to move some precious things into new homes.

As you may recall the idea of a playground originated at a previous AGM and a group of IRARA residents developed the proposal and ran a consultation last summer which generated some strong views – both in favour and against, with a sizeable proportion of the opposition coming from outside the IRARA area. Given the feedback we agreed at the AGM that we could not simply press ahead and the IRARA Committee agreed to discuss the consultation with the respective Councillors which remains a work in progress. We want to thank the residents who got the proposal to this stage of development.

The big Orchard news of last year was the fact that we raised the £45k needed to secure a 999 year lease of the Orchard. This has been a fantastic achievement, and we would like to thank everyone who made this possible.

With most of the legal work now complete, we are hoping to sign the lease in the very near future. Hopefully the blossom will be on display for the Open Day on 28 April. You will also see the fruits of the monthly work parties with the hedge quards now removed (and heading for recycling), a few new trees planted and the composting that allows us to use all of the material generated on-site.
